Johnny has worked with stars such as Van Morrison and Jacqui Dankworth but is also famed for his idiosyncratic and energetic solo piano style.
Tuesday 2nd February	19:00 – 22:30	Adrian York Adrian is the only musician in London to have worked at the 'old' Quaglino's, where his father was musical director in the 1970s, and the new. One of London's top solo pianists with an international reputation he plays all your favourite tunes in his inimitable style. From Ragtime to Ray Charles, Irving Berlin to the Beatles, Cole Porter to Coldplay.

Friday 5th February	19:00 – 23:00	Kai Hoffman Trio American jazz singer Kai Hoffman has performed on three continents, in venues ranging from London's Royal Albert Hall to the Sheraton Hotel in Bangladesh. Her jump jive and swing sextet, Kai's Cats, currently has a residency at Ronnie Scott's Upstairs in Soho. Kai's song list includes hundreds of tunes by the great jazz artists of the 20 th century as well as contemporary figures: Frank Sinatra, the Rat Pack, Cole Porter, Ella Fitzgerald, Nat King Cole, Ray Charles, Louis Armstrong, Diana Krall, Norah Jones, Louis Jordan, Louis Prima, Nina Simone, James Taylor and many more.
Saturday 6th February	13:00 – 16:00	Rod Melvin Rod is a London legend, famous for his work with Ian Dury as well as for his long residencies at L'Escargot, Le Pont de la Tour and The Groucho Club. With his stylish playing and singing he covers a wide range of tunes from different eras in varying styles, from Romantic to Upbeat, Blues to Classical.
	19:00-23:00	Roland Perrin Trio New York City born pianist Roland Perrin reflects the diversity of that great city in his playing which is a synthesis of Jazz, Latin, and Pop styles. His exciting and stylish trio features Cuban bass player Rey Crespo and the exciting Ghanaian singer V.

She is best known for her work with the band Lush Life whose live work included residencies at Ronnie Scotts, London, Cafe de Paris and Le Cafconce in Casablanca.
