One of London's top solo pianists with an international reputation he plays all your favourite tunes in his inimitable style. From Ragtime to Ray Charles, Irving Berlin to the Beatles, Cole Porter to Coldplay.

Friday 5th March	19:00 – 23:00	Anthony Strong Trio London based singer-pianist Anthony Strong writes music infused with jazz, blues, pop and soul and he is currently winning over audiences, one venue at a time, with his infectious feel-good music. His debut album "Guaranteed" is out now.
Saturday 6th March	13:00 – 16:00	Rod Melvin Rod is a London legend, famous for his work with Ian Dury as well as for his long residencies at L'Escargot, Le Pont de la Tour and The Groucho Club. With his stylish playing and singing he covers a wide range of tunes from different eras in varying styles, from Romantic to Upbeat, Blues to Classical.
	19:00-23:00	Roland Perrin Trio New York City born pianist Roland Perrin reflects the diversity of that great city in his playing which is a synthesis of Jazz, Latin, and Pop styles. His exciting and stylish trio features Cuban bass player Rey Crespo and the exciting Ghanaian singer V.
Monday 8th March	19:00-22:30	Johnny Miller As one of the original musicians working at Quaglino's when it reopened in 1993 Johnny has a real history with and understanding of the restaurant. Johnny has worked with stars such as Van Morrison and Jacqui Dankworth but is also famed for his idiosyncratic and energetic solo piano style.
Tuesday 9th March	19:00-22:30	Gunther Kuermeyer Austrian virtuoso Gunther, best known for his work with swing sax maestro Ray Gelato provides a swinging antidote to those winter blues.

Thursday 11th March	19:00-23:00	Ella Jones Ella is one of the new breed of young singer-pianists, think Carole King with some London sass thrown in for good measure! Ella has performed all over London, including the Jazz Cafe and Ronnie Scotts, and in restaurants including Luciano's and Bentley's.

Friday 12 th March	19:00-23:00	Jane Parker Trio Jane Parker's breathy vocals, reminiscent of Rickie Lee Jones or Billie Holliday are as sultry and steamy as the bayou. Jane cut her musical teeth singing in bars and late night drinking clubs in and around London's West End. She is best known for her work with the band Lush Life whose live work included residencies at Ronnie Scotts, London, Cafe de Paris and Le Cafconce in Casablanca.
