HISTORY OF THE COCKTAIL

The word 'cocktail' was first defined in print as a mixture of spirits, sugar, ice & bitters in an American magazine in 1806 but was not in common use.

Universal interest in cocktails came with Prohibition in the United States in the Roaring Twenties- as alcohol was not available, they would put together concoctions of whatever they could find & if the initial result was unpalatable, they would improve them, often successfully, with additives.

SHERRY

Sherry comes from Cadiz which is in the southwest of Spain & is produced in & around the town of Jerez.

The word 'sherry' was also taken from the town of Jerez where by law, any other sherry producing country must state the name & origin on the bottle & then the word 'sherry'.

There are 2 main grape varieties grown- Palomino & Pedro Ximenez.

Sherry styles:

Fino- pale coloured & drunk cold

Manzanilla- this is the lightest & driest of sheries

Amontillado- still dry but with a slightly richer character

Pale cream- dry with a light coloured sweetening added

Oloroso- 2 types- 1) heavy, nutty & dry 2) rich, sweet & dark

BEERS & ALES

Ale was the name given to any fermented drink brewed from malted grain & water. Barley was the most common grain used in the south of England, whilst oats were the usual grain in north & western Britain. Elsewhere, mixed cereals including wheat, oats & even beans were used.

GIN

The origin of gin can be traced back to the late 16th Century & accredited to the Dutch- a brew christened 'genievre' - the Dutch word for juniper, the main ingredient in gin.

The juniper berry must be the predominant ingredient but other botanicals include caraway, angelica root, orange & lemon peel, coriander seed & barks. Each distiller has a secret formula for their gin.

RUM

Rum is the generic term for a distilled cane spirit that was first produced in the West Indies during the 17th Century from the fermented juice of sugar cane or molasses.

**Examples of light bodied rums are distilled in Puerto Rico, Hawaii & Cuba.
Heavy bodied rums are often from Jamaica or Guyana.**

Rum can be produced wherever sugar cane grows.

VODKA

It is unclear whether vodka originated in Russia or Poland. Both were known to be distilling vodka as far back as the 12th Century.

There are no strict guidelines as to what vodka is distilled from- it can be made from any number of grains- corn, wheat, rye- potatoes or grapes. The key to the quality of the vodka lies in the selection of the grain & the source of the water used to dilute the final product.

COGNAC

Cognac, located in the mid West of France, in Charantes. Distillers in Cognac use grades to market their brandy.

VS- Very Special-, where the youngest brandy has been stored for at least 2 years in oak casks.

VSOP- Very Superior Old Pale- where the youngest brandy is stored for at least 4 years in oak casks.

XO- Extra Old- where the youngest brandy is stored for at least 6 years in oak casks.

It is important to note that these are minimum times- many of the brandies will be much older. Most of the brandies that makes the Hennessy Paradis are over a hundred years old.

By blending different aged brandies, the master blenders are able to produce a brandy which is unchanging through generations.

ARMAGNAC

Armagnac, located in South Western France, has the longest recorded history of distillation of all three- Armagnac, Cognac & Calvados- with records dating back to 1405.

Although production levels are far less than in Cognac, it certainly competes in terms of quality. In Armagnac, many distillers produce brandy from a single vintage, which is stated on the label. This allows them to showcase the best that each vintage can offer.

CALVADOS

Calvados, located in the North West of France in Normandy, is made from apples, or a combination of apples & pears, with the first known distillation dating back to 1554.

As with Armagnac, producers will sometimes produce brandy from a single vintage

EAUX DE VIE, GRAPPA & TEQUILA

Eaux de vie

Clear brandy distilled from the fermented mash of fruit.

Grappa

Italian word for a clear brandy distilled not from wine but from the pulpy residue of grape skins left over after wine making.

Tequila

Made from a cactus like plant (Blue Agave) within a specific area- the village of Tequila & its environs. Anything produced outside this area is known as mescal- the drink that contains the worm.

PORT & MADEIRA

Port is the name given to fortified wine produced around the valley of the river Douro in Portugal. It is made by stopping the fermentation before it is complete, with grape spirit or brandy. Many major Port companies were founded by English & Scottish families who still run them today.

Madeira is a liqueur wine from Portugal made on the island with the same name. It is made in the port method stopping fermentation by the addition of spirit to retain sweetness or by the sherry method of blending to produce sweetness. The wine is then put into a hot store & slowly heated. It is this heating which gives the traditional burnt flavours to the wines.
